

Absentee Ballots Available for Town Meeting, April 12, 2011

Absentee ballots for the second session of the Town and School District Meeting (Voting Day) will be available at the Town Clerk's office. Any voter who will be unable to appear at any time during the polling hours of 7 AM to 8 PM due to employment, or who will otherwise be absent from town on election day, or who is unable to go to the polls due to a physical disability or religious observance may vote by absentee ballot.

Voters must send a signed written request for an absentee ballot to the Town Clerk or download and complete an absentee ballot request form from the Town's website at: www.merrimacknh.gov . The form is found in the Town Clerk's section under Elections and Voting.

Written requests or completed forms can be dropped off at the Town Clerk's office or mailed to Town Clerk, Attn: Absentee Ballots, 6 Baboosic Lake Rd, Merrimack, NH 03054.

Absentee ballots can only be given or mailed directly to the person making the request. Spouses, friends, relatives, etc. cannot receive or deliver a ballot for another person.

Voters are reminded that polling place location is based on address on the checklist. If you are unsure of the address used on the checklist, you are urged to check your information on-line or call the Town Clerk's office for the address on file.
